Lecture by Sibylle Omlin

Sibylle Omlin is a curator (born in Zug, has lived in Zürich and Basel, and now lives in Sierre) and writer, whose special interest is art in public space. She has organised several exhibitions in public space, often connected to art institutions located in rural areas (including Altdorf in the Canton of Uri, Davos in the Grisons, or Friedrichshafen on the Lake of Constance). She has tried to introduce forms of art and media into the public sphere that are not self-evident (such as performance and concept art) and that need to be conveyed and framed differently.

She will talk about her experience with art in public space, especially installations and performances. There is a possibility to see the show “La chambre meublée” in K3, curated by her as part of the exhibition series “The Belly of the Whale”.

Please note there will be also a concert with Pe Lang at 8.30 p.m.
